Overview

This bill appropriates \$7.5 million in each year of the 2022-2023 biennium from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for emergency services grants and adds this amount to base funding.

Emergency services grants provide homeless persons essential services and emergency shelter in safe, sanitary, and decent facilities. The grant program helps eligible organizations improve the quality of existing shelters, make available other emergency housing, meet the operating and maintenance costs of shelters, and provide essential services to homeless persons.
