"Subd. 9. Investigative stops based on alerts from automated license plate reader. A positive match by an automatic license plate reader alone is not reasonable suspicion for a law enforcement officer to stop a vehicle. The officer must develop independent reasonable suspicion for the stop by immediately confirming that the license plate on the vehicle matches the image of the license plate displayed on the license plate reader and confirm, by separate means, that the license plate number is on one of the lists specified. Prior to stopping a vehicle based on an alarm, the officer shall attempt to visually verify that the plate number on the list matches the digital image displayed on the license plate reader. If the actual plate number is not the same as that displayed, no stop can be made unless independent grounds for a traffic stop exist."
