Bill Description

This bill requires the commissioner of human services, in consultation with the commissioner of employment and economic development, to review unemployment data for all regions of the state in which a federal SNAP able-bodied adults without dependents time limit waiver is in effect and terminate waivers in regions that no longer meet the federal waiver requirements. The bill also requires the commissioner of human services to receive verification from the commissioner of employment and economic development that the labor market conditions in the region make the federal work requirements untenable before submitting a SNAP able-bodied adults without dependents time limit waiver request to the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Makes this section effective the day following final enactment.

SNAP is a federal program that increases the food purchasing power of low-income households. The Department of Human Services supervises the administration of the program in Minnesota and the counties administer the program at the local level. Minnesota must comply with federal laws and regulations related to the program.

Under federal law and regulations, there are specific work requirements for an eligible group of individuals referred to as able-bodied adults without dependents (ABAWD). This group consists of individuals who:

are between the ages of 18 and 49;

have no dependents; and are not disabled.

Assumptions

This bill adds a step in the submission process which requires the department to send the waiver request to commissioner of employment and economic development to review before submission. This step would not require measurable additional effort by department staff. This program is 100% federally funded. There will be no impact to the general fund as a result of this change.
