

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3608 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. ANOKA COUNTY; HISTORIC AUDITORIUM BUILDING
1.4 RENOVATION.

1.5 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$750,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.6 fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Anoka
1.7 County to predesign, design, construct, renovate, furnish, and equip a renovation of the
1.8 historic auditorium building on the Haven for Heroes campus in the city of Anoka. This
1.9 appropriation includes money for improvements of a capital nature, including major projects
1.10 to preserve or replace mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and HVAC systems; energy
1.11 efficiency upgrades, including window replacement; roof and gutter repairs; Americans
1.12 with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance improvements; upgrades to the auditorium stage,
1.13 including stage lighting replacement; repairs and improvements to interior and exterior
1.14 walls; and other site renovations to support ongoing operations.

1.15 (b) Any unspent portion of this appropriation remaining after completion of the historic
1.16 auditorium building renovation, and after written notice to the commissioner of management
1.17 and budget, is available to predesign and design a museum devoted to the history of the
1.18 Anoka State Hospital and the treatment of mental illness in Minnesota on the Haven for
1.19 Heroes campus in the city of Anoka.

1.20 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.21 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.22 the state in an amount up to \$750,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.23 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.24 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
