Overview

A conviction of a qualified domestic violence-related offense (QDVRO) can be used to enhance the severity and penalty of certain crimes committed within ten years of that conviction. This bill expands the list of crimes that qualify as QDVROs to include first-degree manslaughter, second-degree manslaughter, kidnapping, and false imprisonment.
