Reach the Community

- 252,000 people in the city of St.Paul don't know Jesus or have an affiliation with a faith community
- Dayton's Bluff is a neighborhood that has 20,000 people
- It represents 8 different people groups
- 28% Of the neighborhood is below poverty
- \$34,000,000 wasted because of food insecurity in State of Minnesota.
- 50% of the residents in St.Paul are Food Insecure

Why?

Faith City Church exists to reach 8000 families in Dayton's Bluff who represent people in poverty. We are a grassroots movement ending hunger through community development , economic development and human flourishing. We will build relationships in the neighborhood. By the year 2025 we will hope to have 250 families transitioned out of poverty.

Start Summer Feeding (June 2019)

Started Storehouse Grocery Store (November 2019)

Summer of 2020 Starting serving hot meals twice a week. Served 1600 hot meals a month till 2021.

We started 2 food hubs with churches: One in the Como and Midway neighborhood.
