On behalf of the PACER Center and the Coalition for Children with Disabilities, I am writing in support of H.F. 1559, which provides funding for paid orientation and training for paraprofessionals. We strongly support this bill.

Paraprofessionals play an important role in the education of students with disabilities. In order for paraprofessionals to be most effective, they need to understand the disability of the children with whom they work and be knowledgeable of the accommodations that will help them be successful in the classroom. Providing funding to support paraprofessionals to receive paid orientation and professional development will enable them to better support the individual needs of students with disabilities. Without proper training, paraprofessionals may unintentionally escalate a student's behavior, resulting in additional challenges. Providing opportunities for paraprofessionals to receive training and meet with students' teachers will be beneficial to both students and professionals.
