Sec. 2. **GUARDIAN AD LITEM BOARD** **\$** **0** **\$** **2,940,000**

This appropriation is to hire additional guardians ad litem to comply with federal and state mandates and court orders for representing the best interests of children in juvenile and family court proceedings. The general fund base for this appropriation is \$1,871,000 beginning in fiscal year 2020.

Subd. 2. Task Force on Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women

\$48,000 is from the general fund for the Task Force on Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women. The general fund base for this appropriation shall be \$45,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$0 in fiscal year 2021.

2.13 This appropriation is to fund the offender
2.14 health care contract. \$1,968,000 is added to
2.15 the base in fiscal year 2020 and \$3,168,000 is
2.16 added to the base in fiscal year 2021 and
2.17 beyond.

2.18 **Sec. 5. HUMAN SERVICES** **\$** **0** **\$** **12,000**

2.19 This appropriation is for state costs to update
2.20 a paternity training video. This is a onetime
2.21 appropriation.

2.22 **Sec. 6. TRANSFER; PEACE OFFICER TRAINING ACCOUNT DEFICIENCY.**

2.23 \$125,000 is transferred in fiscal year 2019 from the general fund to the peace officer
2.24 training account in the special revenue fund to pay for a projected deficiency in the peace
2.25 officer training account. This is a onetime transfer.

2.26 **Sec. 7. TRANSFER; FEDERAL DISASTER, DR-4069.**

2.27 The commissioner of management and budget must transfer any unexpended balance
2.28 appropriated to the Department of Public Safety for Federal Disaster DR-4069 under Laws
2.29 2012, First Special Session chapter 1, article 1, section 3, subdivision 2, as amended by
2.30 Laws 2013, First Special Session chapter 1, section 2, paragraph (a), to the disaster
