This bill establishes a purple heart designation on driver's licenses and Minnesota identification cards. State park permits are provided. Section 2 is effective the day following final enactment and applies to applications submitted on or after the later of (1) January 1, 2016, or (2) the date that relevant modules of new driver and vehicle services information technology system are first implemented.

Bill Description

The bill amends MS 85.053 to provide a free daily permit to the park to those who have documentation that they have been awarded a purple heart.

Assumptions

Subdivision 11 will only apply to Minnesota residents.

Individuals who would be eligible under this amendment are already eligible for a free daily permit under MS 85.053. This law already allows exemptions for disabled persons, disabled veterans, and military personnel. A person who has been awarded a purple heart would already fall into those categories.

It appears from the language that this exception would not apply to the surviving family members if the purple heart was awarded posthumously.
