The Green Isle EDA supports this refrigerated warehouse project as part of their mission to provide economic development and job creation in the City of Green Isle.

Bartels and the City of Green Isle are planning to fill a longstanding vacant space within the City. The Green Isle Industrial Park was built in 2004 and remained largely unoccupied while the residents of Green Isle have been burdened with higher taxes to pay for the industrial park and infrastructure.

This project will benefit the City of Green Isle and other communities in the region. The Green Isle Refrigerated Warehouse will store products for Michael Foods Inc. that are currently being driven down to Iowa for cold storage. In the past, Michael Foods has had to stop production in some of their plants because of the lack of refrigerated space. This has put them in a situation of possibly shorting customer orders.

The refrigerated warehouse will also service companies like Bongards and AMPI keeping their cold storage in the state of Minnesota. The City of Green Isle is granting the project Tax Incremental Financing as it will produce a significant number of jobs within the community that will pay an average of \$22.60 per hour.

I strongly support and recommend this cold storage construction project in Green Isle and applaud Bartels trucking for their investment in rural Minnesota.
