Chair Champion, Chair Hassan, Chair Xiong, and Members of the Conference Committee,

Thank you so much for including an appropriation for the Getting to Work Grant Program in your omnibus budget bills.

My name is Ann Macgregor and I'm the Partnership and Development Coordinator at Minnesota Valley Action Council. MVAC is the Community Action Agency that serves the nine counites in South Central Minnesota. MVAC received a Getting to Work grant in 2022, and I appreciate the opportunity to share the impact that funding has made for our clients.

MVAC developed a program by leveraging the Getting to Work funds with Agency Funds and enrolling all participants in the Family Assets for Independence Program (known as FAIM). The Agency purchased 6 new vehicles to lease out to participants who otherwise would not be eligible for traditional financing.

Participants agree to participate in Financial Wellness and Car Maintenance classes, and to meet with staff monthly to make their payments. During this visit, staff ensure they are completing the necessary vehicle maintenance and check in with them to see if they need any other support or resources. This allows us to help them when an issue arises, but before it becomes a crisis.

One participant, a single dad, works as a contracted employee to deliver for Walmart. The vehicle that he owned was at the point of needing car repairs quite frequently. He would dip into his budget to make the repairs only to have something else go wrong. As a contracted employee, he only gets paid for the deliveries made. If his car was in for repairs, he wouldn't earn money. So, by getting him in this program, he can work every day and not have to spend money on repairs. He has the money to put into his savings and will eventually own his car.

Thank you for the good work you do to support economic opportunity for all Minnesotans.
