Bill Description

HF492-2A amends Minn. Stat. § 169.13, subd. 2 (Careless Driving), by adding a paragraph (b), which makes it a misdemeanor to operate or halt any vehicle upon any street or highway in violation of chapter 169 and cause great bodily harm to death to another, and a paragraph (c), which states that a person charged with a violation of paragraph (b) who is not arrested, taken into custody, and detained until the first court appearance must be issued a summons for a court appearance and that the violation may not be on the Statewide Payables List.

Assumptions

It is assumed that the provisions of this bill will not impact case filings as no new offenses are created, and will not impact the resources requires to process existing offenses. Any violation of chapter 169 that is committed in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property is already a misdemeanor under current law (Minn. Stat. § 169.89, subd. 1(1)), and not a payable offense under the Statewide Payable Offense Policy.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

As the provisions of this bill do not create any new offenses, do not change the level of offense for any existing offenses, and do not otherwise significantly impact the Judicial Branch workload, the provisions of this bill will not have a significant fiscal impact on the Judicial Branch.
