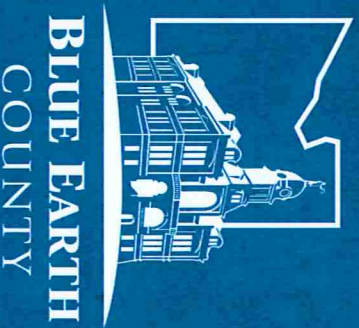

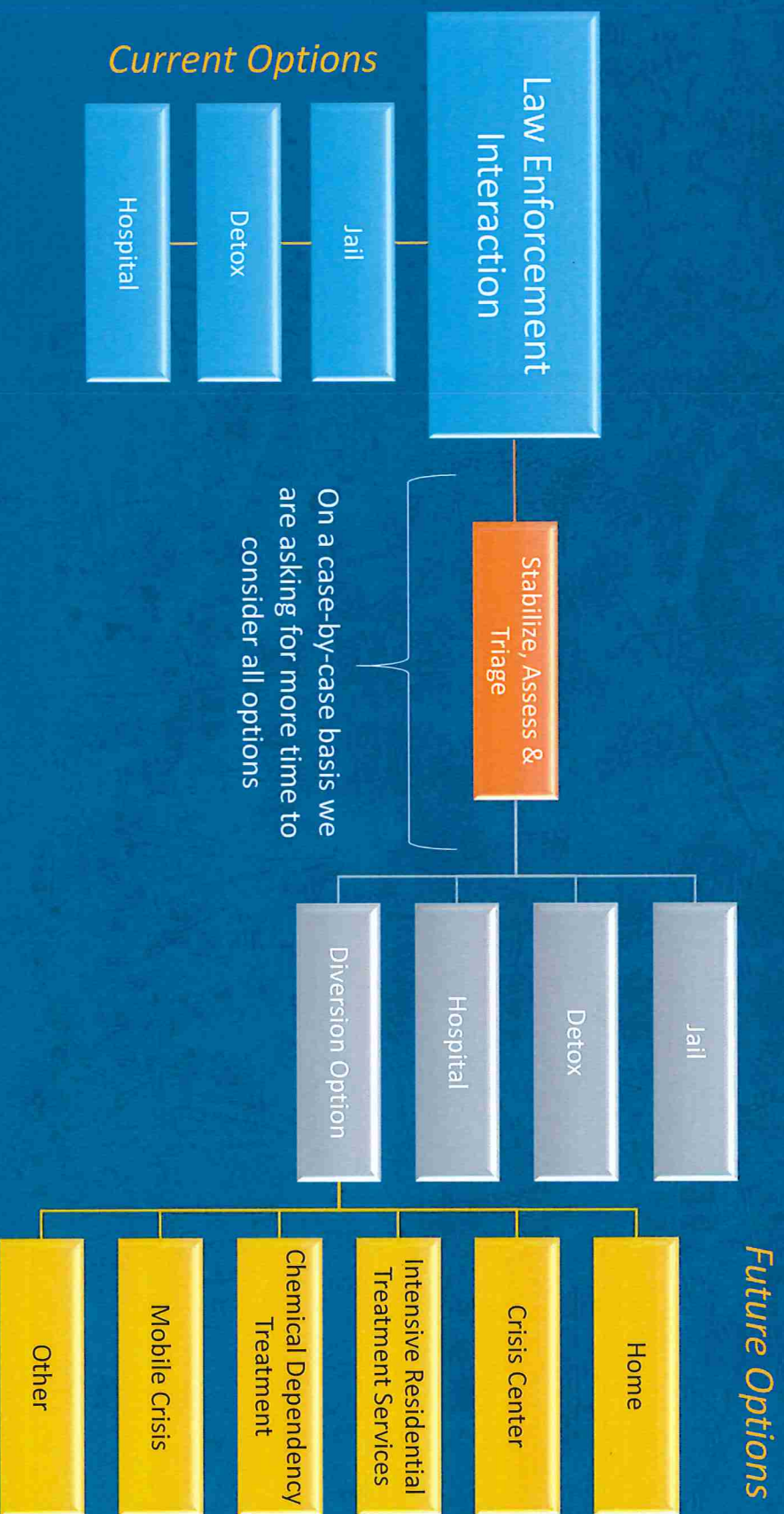

- Out-of-Scope: Individuals who are a risk of harm to self or others (a public safety risk), and high-end victim crimes

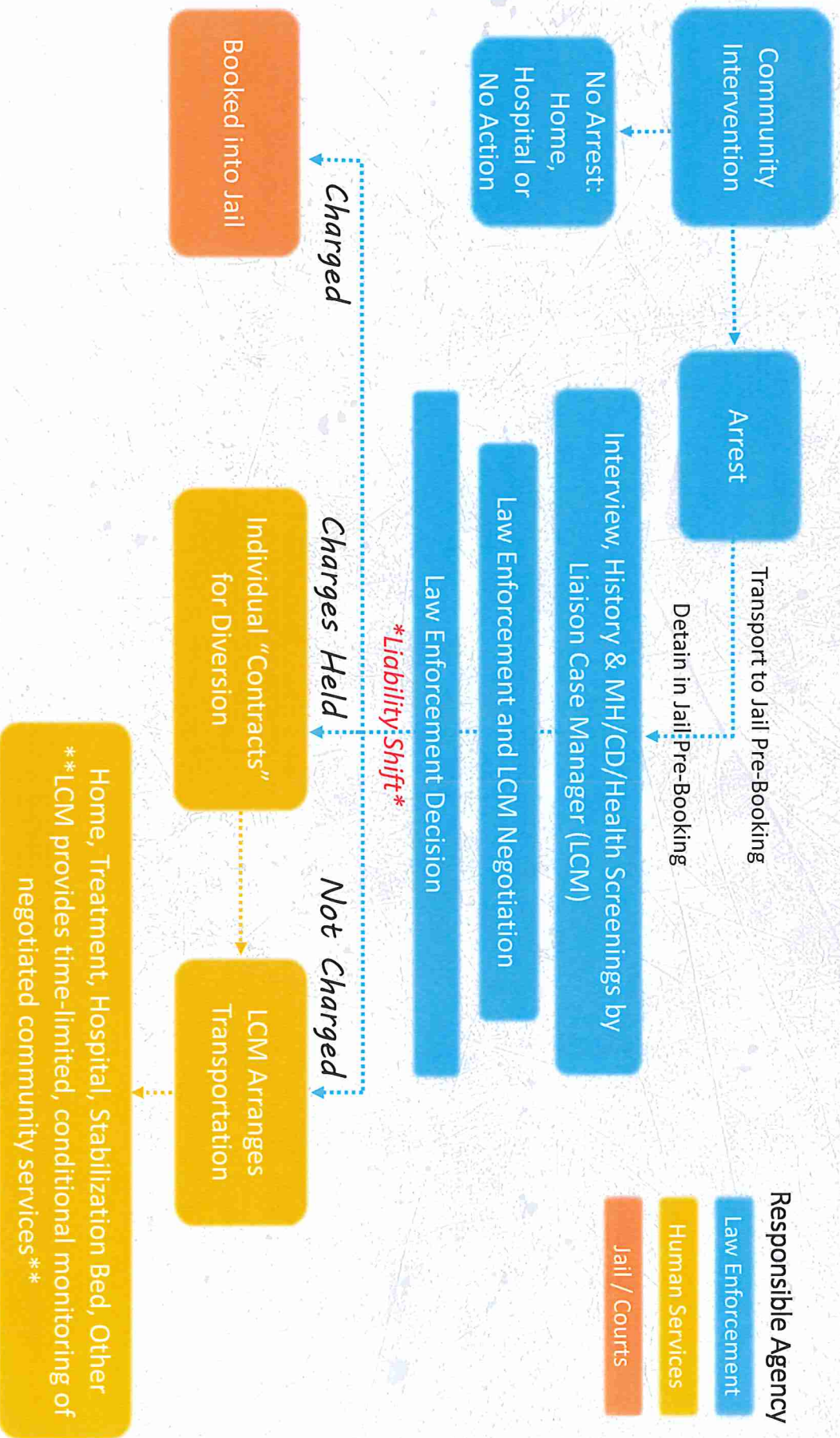
A Strategic Shift

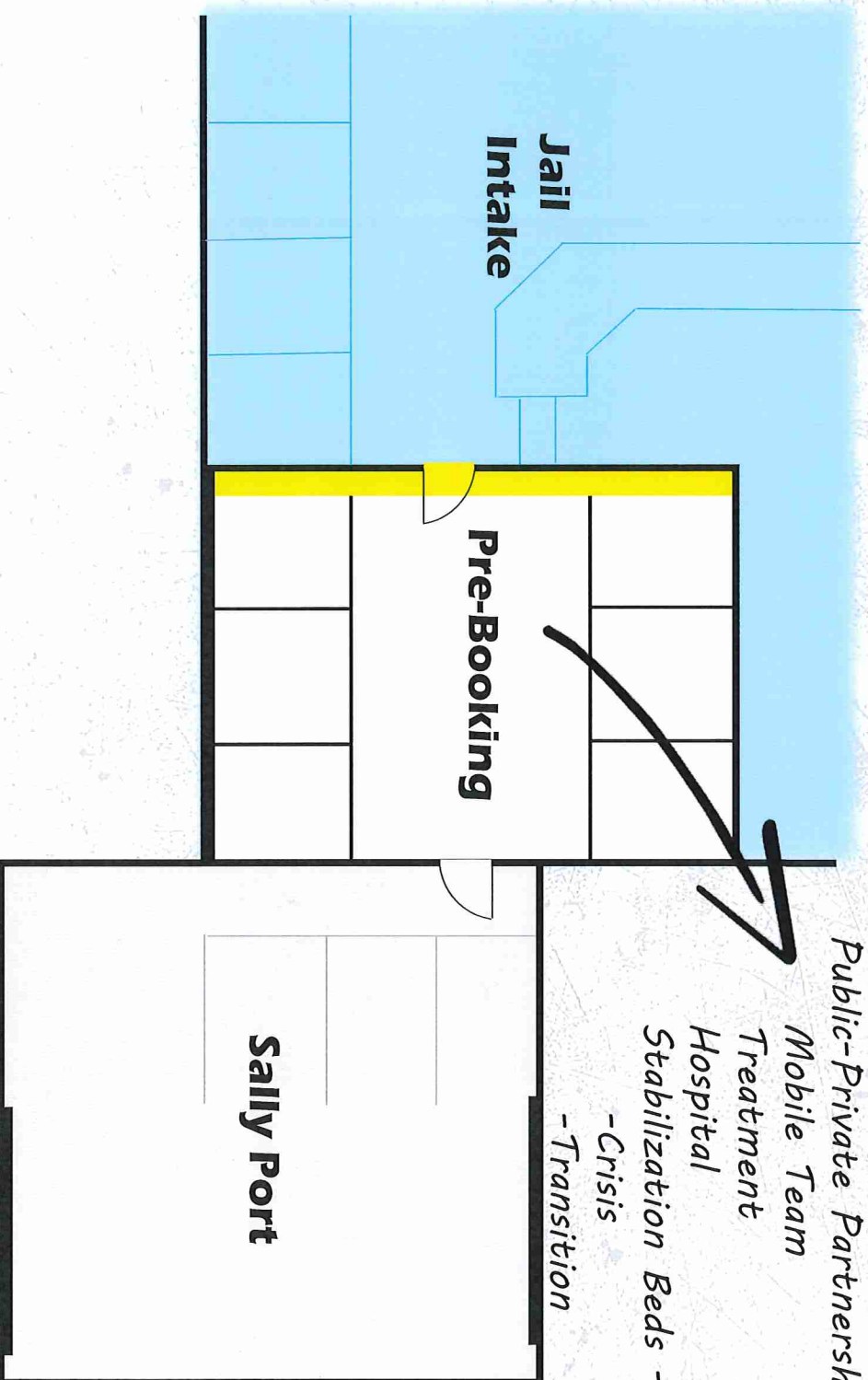
