Summary

This bill establishes a three-year short-call substitute teacher pilot program. It allows a district to employ a person who meets the professional requirements for a Tier 1 teacher as a short-call substitute teacher without the person obtaining a license from the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board (PELSB). Limits each assignment to no more than 15 consecutive school days. Requires a report to PELSB on persons employed under the pilot program.
