Minnesota Diversified Industries (MDI) is a non-profit 501(c)(3) and a social enterprise, providing manufacturing jobs for people with disabilities. Across our four locations, Minneapolis, Grand Rapids, Hibbing, and Cohasset, people with and without disabilities work side-by-side, producing logistics containers and providing business services for our B2B customers. They return again and again because of our quality products and outstanding customer service.

A job at MDI gives a person with disabilities a sense of success and independence – often for the first time in their lives.

Funding received from a State of Minnesota Workforce Development appropriation has been critical to supporting the success and independence of employees with disabilities at MDI over the years.

The 2018 MN State Legislative Appropriation was reduced from \$450k to \$100k for 2019 and 2020 fiscal years. To address this \$350k deficit MDI left three positions unfilled and decrease services for people with disabilities.

Can you help restore services and state funding to MDI?

- MDI employed 562 people, 183 of whom are people with disabilities at year end.
- 2020 wages and benefits paid to employees and contract employees were \$17.7 million.
- Everyone at MDI earns at least minimum wage and receives full benefits.
- MDI's goal is to employ 600 people by end of 2021, 50 % of whom are people with disabilities.
