1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 124D.20, subdivision 3, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 3. General community education revenue. The general community education
1.8	revenue for a district equals \$5.42 for fiscal year 2007 through fiscal year 2024 and \$6.35
1.9	for fiscal year 2025 and later, times the greater of 1,335 or the population of the district.
1.10	The population of the district is determined according to section 275.14.
1.11	Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 124D.20, subdivision 4a, is amended to read:
1.12	Subd. 4a. Youth after-school enrichment revenue. In fiscal year 2003 and thereafter,

1.14	enrichment program under section 124D.19, subdivision 12, equals:
1.15	(1) \$1.85 times the greater of 1,335 or the population of the district, as defined in section

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Subd. 5. **Total community education levy.** To obtain total community education revenue, a district may levy the amount raised by a maximum tax rate of 0.94 percent through fiscal year 2024, 0.375 percent in fiscal year 2025, 0.3298 percent in fiscal year 2026, and 0.3128 percent in fiscal year 2027 and later, times the adjusted net tax capacity of the district. If the amount of the total community education levy would exceed the total community education revenue, the total community education levy shall be determined according to subdivision 6.
