1.3 Page 3, delete section 2 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 43A.17, is amended by adding a subdivision to
1.5 read:

1.6 Subd. 13. Compensation for law enforcement officers. (a) For purposes of this
1.7 subdivision, the term "law enforcement officers" means all licensed peace officers employed
1.8 by the state who are included in the state units under section 179A.10, subdivision 2,
1.9 including without limitation: Minnesota State Patrol troopers, Bureau of Criminal
1.10 Apprehension agents, and Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement agents, in the Department
1.11 of Public Safety; Department of Natural Resources conservation officers; Department of
1.12 Corrections Fugitive Apprehension Unit members; and Commerce Fraud Bureau agents in
1.13 the Department of Commerce.

1.14 (b) When the commissioner of management and budget negotiates a collective bargaining
1.15 agreement establishing compensation for law enforcement officers, the commissioner must
1.16 use compensation and benefit data from the most recent salary and benefits survey conducted
1.17 pursuant to section 299D.03, subdivision 2a, to compare salaries to ensure appropriate
1.18 increases are made to law enforcement officer salaries and benefits.

1.19 EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION. This section is effective the day following
1.20 final enactment and expires January 1, 2032. This section applies to contracts entered into
1.21 on or after the effective date but before January 1, 2032."
