
Our Plan

Studio Technical Arts Campus (STAC) \$1.5M Capital Investment

Workforce development that supports BIPOC young people in gaining pathways to well-paying careers and addresses the lack of BIPOC representation in theatre tech and media.

Renovation of property to build STAC

tech theatre, design, fabrication, media, journalism, radio station

- 50 young people ready for high paying union jobs
