Bill Description

Approves a pilot program to develop, install, and administer self-service kiosks allowing customers to renew vehicle registration and receive stickers through the kiosks unassisted by a Deputy Registrar. The kiosk will be an extension of the Registrar's office though and Registrar will be responsible for assistance when requested.

Assumptions

Assumes legislation is effective the day following final enactment.

Assumes Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) resources will be needed to update the DVS Info Hub website with updated with information on Kiosks. Assume 40 hours for time x \$23.27 per hour = \$930.80 to develop and update DVS Info Hub site, which will be absorbed by DVS as part of their regular work.

Assumes the need for a Vehicle Services Management Analyst to create the required Legislative Report by January 1, 2024 showing data statistics for the pilot project including the number of completed transactions, the number of failed or canceled transactions and any recommendations to improve the program, and whether to implement it permanently and suggested legislation.

Assumes Vehicle Services Management Analyst will need 40 hours for time x \$24.88 per hour = \$995.20 to complete the Legislative Report, which will be absorbed by DVS as part of their regular work.

Assume a Request for Proposal (RFP) will document the requirements of the kiosk vendor to manage inventory, train users, provide maintenance to the kiosks, and complete the physical installation of the kiosks.

Assumes 1,250 programming hours (31.25 weeks) are required at a rate of \$200 per hour (or \$8,000 per week) for a total programming cost of \$250,000 to setup the programming, interfaces, and testing in MNDRIVE to implement the pilot project legislation.

Assume DVS will receive a one-time general fund appropriation to implement the pilot program.
