1.3 Page 82, after line 20, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 66. **EXAMINING AND DEVELOPING STATEWIDE SWIMMING**
1.5 **RESOURCES.**

1.6 (a) The commissioner of education must use existing budgetary resources to
1.7 inventory and report to the education committees of the legislature by February 1, 2016,
1.8 on the extent of existing resources and best practices available for swimming instruction
1.9 in Minnesota public schools.

1.10 (b) The commissioner of education must establish a work group of interested
1.11 stakeholders, including the commissioner or commissioner's designee, the commissioner
1.12 of health or the commissioner's designee, and representatives of K-12 physical education
1.13 teachers, K-12 school administrators, the Minnesota school boards association, nonprofit
1.14 fitness and recreational organizations, public parks and recreation departments, and
1.15 other stakeholders, including community members underserved and disproportionately
1.16 impacted by the current distribution of swimming resources, interested in swimming
1.17 instruction and activities identified by the commissioner of education, to determine
1.18 and report to the education committees of the legislature by February 1, 2016, on the
1.19 curriculum, resources, personnel, and other costs needed to make swimming instruction
1.20 available in all Minnesota public schools for children beginning at an early age. The work
1.21 group must consider the substance of the report under paragraph (a) in preparing its report.

1.22 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
