1.4 "Sec. 13. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97A.075, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Deer, bear, and lifetime licenses.** (a) For purposes of this  
1.6 subdivision, "deer license" means a license issued under section 97A.475, subdivisions 2,  
1.7 clauses (5), (6), (7), (13), (14), and (15); 3, paragraph (a), clauses (2), (3), (4), (10), (11),  
1.8 and (12); and 8, paragraph (b), and licenses issued under section 97B.301, subdivision 4.

1.9 (b) \$2 from each annual deer license and \$2 annually from the lifetime fish and  
1.10 wildlife trust fund, established in section 97A.4742, for each license issued under  
1.11 section 97A.473, subdivision 4, shall be credited to the deer management account and  
1.12 is appropriated to the commissioner for deer habitat improvement or deer management  
1.13 programs.

1.14 (c) \$1 from each annual deer license and each bear license and \$1 annually from  
1.15 the lifetime fish and wildlife trust fund, established in section 97A.4742, for each  
1.16 license issued under section 97A.473, subdivision 4, shall be credited to the deer and  
1.17 bear management account and is appropriated to the commissioner for deer and bear  
1.18 management programs, including a computerized licensing system.

1.19 (d) Fifty cents from each deer license is credited to the emergency deer feeding and  
1.20 wild cervidae health management account and is appropriated for emergency deer feeding  
1.21 and wild cervidae health management. Money appropriated for emergency deer feeding  
1.22 and wild cervidae health management is available until expended.

1.23 When the unencumbered balance in the appropriation for emergency deer feeding

2.6 Subd. 7. **Wolf licenses; account established.** (a) For purposes of this subdivision,  
2.7 "wolf license" means a license or permit issued under section 97A.475, subdivision 2,  
2.8 clause (20); 3, paragraph (a), clause (16); or 20, paragraph (b).

2.9 (b) A wolf management and monitoring account is created in the game and fish fund.  
2.10 Revenue from wolf licenses must be credited to the wolf management and monitoring  
2.11 account and ~~is appropriated to the commissioner~~ may be used only for wolf management,  
2.12 research, damage control, enforcement, and education. Money credited to the account  
2.13 may only be expended as appropriated by law.

2.14 Sec. 15. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 97B.647, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

2.15 Subd. 6. **Application for license.** An application for a wolf hunting or wolf trapping  
2.16 license must be made in a manner provided by the commissioner and accompanied by a  
2.17 \$4 application fee and proof that the applicant holds a current or previous year hunting  
2.18 license. The \$4 application fee shall be credited to the wolf management and monitoring  
2.19 account and ~~appropriated to the commissioner~~ may be used only to pay for costs associated  
2.20 with conducting the wolf license drawing and wolf management. A person may not make  
2.21 more than one application for each season as prescribed by the commissioner. If a person  
2.22 makes more than one application, the person is ineligible for a license for that season after  
2.23 determination by the commissioner, without a hearing."
