#### Who we serve


#### **Steve and Eva**

- Steve is in the county jail. He was deemed incompetent to stand trial and placed under civil commitment to the Commissioner.
- Per the 48-hour law, he is transferred to Anoka.
- Steve needs clinical services for restoration but does not require a hospital-level of care.
- He remains at Anoka, using a hospital bed needed by Eva, who is at a community hospital on a waiting list for Anoka.


#### **Terry**

- Terry is a 21-year-old who became suicidal in college.
- He has been in and out of emergency departments and hospitals for three years.
- Terry waited for six weeks at an emergency department for a bed in Anoka.
- Once he finally was accepted to Anoka he had decompensated significantly and required 1:1 care.






