Bill Description

Section 1 amends M.S. 14.46, subdivision 3 to reflect the updated technology used by the State Register.

Section 2 amends M.S. 14.46, subdivision 4 to eliminate the distribution of paper copies of the State Register to public libraries in each county since it is available for free on the state's website. It also updates the name of the state's website.

Section 3 amends M.S. 16B.2405, subdivision 2 to clarify the events that are to be included in the annual report for Capitol Event Fees. It also changes the date the report is due each year.

Assumptions

Changes described in sections 1 and 2 have already occurred due to improvements in technology.

Section 3 will streamline the annual report to include only events that are charged a fee. The report due date will be changed to September 15 to allow sufficient time for the Department of Administration to prepare the report after the close of each fiscal year.

This bill has no cost impact.
