Increase Teachers of Color Act of 2020

What does ITCA 2020 accomplish?

The proposed legislation strengthens existing programs for attracting, preparing, and retaining an increased percentage of teachers of color and American Indian teachers (TOCAIT) in Minnesota. It promotes needed system change to help close opportunity and achievement gaps and increase TOCAIT.



What does ITCA 2020 include as a package of legislation in the House?

- Updated policy amendments for existing E12 and Higher Ed programs proposed in ITCA 2019 that
 were approved in the House with bipartisan support but were not included in the final House-Senate
 Conference Committee omnibus bills.
- Requests for one-time, additional funding for FY21 for the most important existing Education and Higher Education grant programs funded in 2019 if there is a state budget surplus.

E12 Policy & Finance Proposals in HF3201

(Reps. Kunesh-Podein & Koznick, et. al.)

- Establishes a state goal to increase the percentage of TOCAIT each year (currently 4%) and have a teaching force reflect the diversity of K12 students (currently 34%) in the state by 2040. Requires a biennial accountability report from PELSB. (Sec. 3, pp. 3-4)
- Creates statute to expand and strengthen the Grow Your Own program with additional pathways for non-licensed employees, parents and secondary students, and opens eligibility for districts throughout the state. (Sec. 5, pp. 5-9)
- Requires district plans under the World's Best Workforce and Achievement & Integration statutes to ensure curriculum, learning, and work environments are inclusive and respectful of all racial and ethnic groups. The Achievement & Integration program is strengthened to address opportunity and achievement gaps. (Sec. 1 & 2, pp. 1-3, and Sec. 6, pp. 9-11)
- Requires the testing company offering licensure exams to provide more supports for candidate success including monthly untimed test taking opportunities, waiving testing fees for low income test takers, and providing free full-length practice tests for each exam, etc. (Sec. 4, p. 5)
- Proposes additional, one-time funding (amounts TBD) for three grant programs: 1) Grow Your Own, 2) Teacher Mentorship and Retention, and 3) Collaborative Urban and Greater MN Educator of Color (Sec. 7)

Higher Ed <u>Amendments</u> to HF434 (Rep. Noor, et. al.)

- Strengthens Student Teacher Candidate Grants in Shortage Areas to clarify most needed shortage areas in the state and target financial support to candidates accordingly.

 Amends 2019 session law to clarify that \$750K appropriated for TOCAIT candidates is in addition to amount reserved per statute. Seeks additional funding. (Sec. 1, pp. 1-4, Sec. 3 & 4, pp. 8-9)
- Strengthens Teacher Shortage
 Loan Forgiveness program to
 clarify most needed shortage
 areas in the state so limited
 funds support those teachers
 and reserves a percentage of
 funds for TOCAIT equal to the
 percentage of students of
 color and American Indian
 students in MN. (Sec. 2, pp. 4-8)
