This prevention program serves women who have a history of chemical dependency or abuse and are either pregnant or parenting dependent children. The program provides intervention, treatment support and recovery maintenance through individual and group services. Other services include but are not limited to case management, resource and referrals, advocacy, transportation and basic needs. The program meets the needs of the families by providing a unique setting that caters to pregnant or parenting women who struggle with substance abuse or dependence.
