Bill Description

If enacted, this bill would:

- Change references to the prescription repository program to the medication repository program
- Appropriate an unspecified amount of money from the General Fund to the Board of Pharmacy
- Direct the Board to contract with the medication repository program vendor (the Board currently as a memorandum of understanding in place)
- As part of the contract, require the board to transfer to the central repository vendor the money appropriated by the Legislature to the Board that is meant to be used by the vendor to operate the program
- Require the vendor to report certain data to the Board
- Require the Board to annually audit the expenditure by the vendor of any funds appropriated by the Legislature and given to the vendor
- Formally allows the vendor to seek sources of funding other than the appropriation from the Legislature

Assumptions

There will be minimal costs involved in developing the new contract, passing the appropriation along to the vendor, and auditing the vendor. It is anticipated that less than \$1,000 per year for staff salary and benefits would be expended, which can be absorbed within the Board’s current appropriation. Consequently, the expenditures will be determined by the size of the appropriation granted by the Legislature.

Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula

The expenditures will be determined by the size of the appropriation made by the Legislature.

Long-Term Fiscal Considerations

This will depend on how long the Legislature continues any appropriation made.
