

Good afternoon,

This morning in Environment Conference Committee, Senators Ingebrigtsen and Tomassoni had questions about electric vehicles in Minnesota. Below is information we've compiled in answer to these questions.

1. Current EV production companies in Minnesota:
 - Zeus Electric – Manufacturer of heavy duty electric truck chassis, White Bear Lake
 - e-Ride Industries – Manufacturer of Low Speed “Neighborhood” Electric Vehicles, Princeton
 - ZEF Energy – Charging Stations, Montevideo
 - New Flyer – Manufacturer of electric busses, St. Cloud
2. Zeus Electric is just about to move into their new facility in White Bear lake, which will allow them to make up to 100 electric truck chassis per year.
3. We are aware of one example of cold weather testing of electric vehicles, which was last winter in Baudette by Revian Automotive.
4. There are 100 Chevy Bolts being purchased for EV SPOT Network, a [St. Paul and Minneapolis car sharing project](#), details below.
 - 70 chargers in St. Paul and Minneapolis (10 to 12 of them will be DC Fast chargers)
 - Launch in Summer of 2021 with 100 Chevy Bolts and many street side chargers installed
 - Project completion with additional 50 cars and total of 70 chargers by Summer 2022
