The Minnesota Police and Peace Officers Association (MPPOA) is the largest association representing police and peace officers in the State of Minnesota.

MPPOA supports HF396, legislation that will require the safe storage of firearms and ammunition.

A key part of responsible gun ownership is securing and storing guns while they are not in use. Here are a few reasons why:

- Kids are curious. Even if you have talked to them many times about gun safety, they can't truly understand how dangerous guns are. If they come across a loaded gun, they can accidentally hurt or kill themselves or someone else. If they find it, they may play with it.
- A gun in the house also can be used to hurt or kill someone when:
 - A child or teen finds the gun and accidentally pulls the trigger.
 - A depressed teen or adult feels suicidal and there is a gun readily available.
 - A family argument gets out of control.
 - A family member or friend is mistaken for an intruder.

Safe storage, including using gun locks, can prevent tragedies like these and gun owners have a responsibility to make certain guns are stored safely.

For the reasons above, MPPOA supports HF396.
