Chair Halverson:

Thank you for including a provision in the amendment to SF 2130 that will allow the City of Roseville to issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license for Roseville Cedarholm Golf Course. I am writing to express the City's full support for this provision.

The design and construction of the new Cedarholm Clubhouse and Community Building was a true grassroots effort that included an extensive, multi-year, community engagement process to develop a facility that served all of Roseville. The ability for users to have a craft beer or wine on the scenic patio overlooking the golf course has been an integral part of the community's vision for the facility throughout the process. Throughout the first 18 months of operating the building with a 3.2 liquor license, we continue to receive significant interest from the community regarding our ability to move to a full license to allow for local craft beer and wine.

A provision for Roseville to issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license for Roseville Cedarholm Golf Course is fully supported by the City staff, the community, the Parks and Recreation Commission and City Council.
