Bill Description

The bill extends the sunset date for the Legislative Commission on Data Practices (LCDP) to June 30, 2026 and provides appropriations to the Legislative Coordinating Commission for the LCDP.

Assumptions

- 1. The LCDP consists of eight members; four senators, four representatives. For this note we assume that no additional members will be appointed to the commission.
- 2. The LCDP will meet within the Capitol complex four times each fiscal year beginning FY20. The fiscal note is based on costs of all meetings being conducted during interims.
- Although the bill does not provide for payment of per diems or reimbursement of expenses for legislative members serving on the LCDP, this note assumes that with additional appropriations members will be reimbursed for meeting participation cost beginning FY20.
- Legislative member meeting participation cost include the following per member per interim meeting: per diem (\$86 senators, \$66 representatives), \$88 round trip mileage (152 round trip mile average), and lodging for half of the members (\$150 senators, \$150 representatives).
- 5. Although legislative staff have privided provide part-time research assistance to the commission, we were requested to project the cost of a full-time employee dedicated to provide in depth research analysis to the LCDP. This note assumes that a 1.0 FTE research analyst will be hired in July, 2019 (FY20) to provide in-depth research and analysis support to the commission. Compensation cost for the analyst will include salary (increased 2.5% in FY21, no increase beyond), FICA cost (constant at 7.65%) and employer contribution for health insurance (increase by 5.63% in FY20, no increase beyond) and Unclassified retirement plan (constant at 6.25%).
- Rented state office space will need to be arranged and built-out in FY20. Rental space is projected to increase 2.5% annually. Office equipment will need to be procured in FY20 for the new hire. Office operations cost of supplies, printing and travel will be incurred each fiscal year beginning FY20.
- 7. The LCC will continue to provide administrative oversight and fiscal support services for the research analyst and the LCDP. Nominal cost will be absorbed.
