"Section 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment is adopted, article IV, section 17, will read:

Sec. 17. No law shall embrace more than one subject, which shall be expressed in its title. The title of a bill must not be amended after the bill is introduced in the legislature unless the title is amended to reflect changes to the bill that further limit the scope of the bill. If a court of law with proper jurisdiction deems a bill enacted into law constituting a portion of the state biennial budget unconstitutional for violating this section, the effect of the ruling is the defunding of an existing agency, department, program, or other existing services or benefits of state government, and the state legislature is not in session, the governor must call a special session of the state legislature within seven days of the date a court finds the biennial budgetary law unconstitutional to allow the legislature to address the unconstitutional biennial budgetary law."
