1.5 The commissioner of human services shall review title VII of the federal Bipartisan
1.6 Budget Act of 2018, the Family First Prevention Services Act, and present findings on the
1.7 following subjects to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over child welfare by
1.8 January 31, 2019:

1.9 (1) new services available to the state, counties, and tribes that are eligible for
1.10 reimbursement under title IV-E of the Social Security Act, and:

1.11 (i) the populations eligible for the new services;

1.12 (ii) the duration during which the new services may be provided;

1.13 (iii) state requirements to obtain reimbursement under title IV-E of the Social Security
1.14 Act; and

1.15 (iv) the rates at which different state, county, and tribal expenditures may be reimbursed;

1.16 (2) changes to requirements under title IV-B of the Social Security Act related to family
1.17 reunification including, but not limited to, additional funds or services that may be available
1.18 to assist families and children affected by substance use disorder;

1.19 (3) new or modified federal rules and licensing standards for relative family foster care
1.20 placement, and recommendations for achieving state compliance with federal requirements;

1.21 (4) changes to federal requirements regarding children who are not placed in family
1.22 foster care, and recommendations for achieving state compliance with federal requirements;

1.23 and

- 2.1 (5) any other requirements, grants, or funding in the Family First Prevention Services
- 2.2 Act related to child welfare, foster care, or adoption services in Minnesota."
