1.2 Page 1, delete lines 8 to 10 and insert:

1.3 "The commissioner of management and budget shall transfer \$9,635,000 from the  
1.4 general fund to the disaster assistance contingency account under Minnesota Statutes,  
1.5 section 12.221, subdivision 6, in fiscal year 2015 to provide: (1) the state cost-share for  
1.6 federal assistance under Minnesota Statutes, section 12A.15, subdivision 1; and (2) state  
1.7 public disaster assistance under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 12B."

1.8 Page 2, after line 18, insert:

1.9 "Sec. 5. **DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES; APPROPRIATION.**

1.10 (a) \$10,683,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
1.11 commissioner of human services for the purposes specified by and to supplement the  
1.12 appropriations in Laws 2013, chapter 108, article 14, as amended by Laws 2014, chapter  
1.13 312, article 30, and Laws 2013, chapter 108, article 15.

1.14 (b) The commissioner of human services shall expend the appropriation in paragraph

1.15 (a) as follows:

1.16 (1) \$246,000 for the Minnesota food assistance program under Minnesota Statutes,  
1.17 section 256D.053; and

1.18 (2) \$10,437,000 for the Minnesota Security Hospital under Minnesota Statutes,  
1.19 section 253.20.

1.20 Sec. 6. **DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES; APPROPRIATION.**

1.21 (a) \$568,000 is appropriated in fiscal year 2015 to the commissioner of natural  
1.22 resources for enforcement activities under Laws 2013, chapter 114, article 3, section 4,  
1.23 subdivision 7.

1.24 (b) The appropriation under paragraph (a) shall consist of the following:

1.25 (1) \$69,000 from the general fund;

1.26 (2) \$128,000 from the natural resources fund; and

2.1 (3) \$371,000 from the game and fish fund.

2.2 **Sec. 7. ZOOLOGICAL BOARD; APPROPRIATION.**

2.3 \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the general fund to the Zoological  
2.4 Board to supplement the appropriation in Laws 2013, chapter 114, article 3, section 8.

2.5 **Sec. 8. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; APPROPRIATIONS.**

2.6 (a) \$891,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
2.7 commissioner of health for costs of statewide planning, coordination, preparation, and  
2.8 response activities related to Ebola emergency response. Federal funds awarded to the  
2.9 state for Ebola-related costs on or after December 19, 2014, and before July 1, 2015,  
2.10 shall be used to reduce state expenditures to the extent permitted under federal law. This  
2.11 appropriation is available for expenditures between July 1, 2014, and June 30, 2015.  
2.12 Any unspent funds shall cancel.

2.13 (b) \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
2.14 commissioner of health to provide grants for Ebola related expenditures to Unity Hospital  
2.15 in Fridley, Children's Hospitals and Clinics of Minnesota - Saint Paul Campus, Mayo  
2.16 Clinic Hospital - Saint Mary's Campus and the University of Minnesota Medical Center,  
2.17 and to the eight emergency medical services regional boards for the purpose of defraying  
2.18 costs associated with equipping, supplying, and staffing, including physical plant changes,  
2.19 and the delivery of emergency medical services to treat Ebola patients or suspected Ebola  
2.20 patients. Grants shall be made for costs incurred on or after July 1, 2014. n entity seeking  
2.21 a grant must submit an application in a form prescribed by the commissioner that includes  
2.22 documentation of eligible expenditures that the hospital or emergency medical services  
2.23 regional board is seeking to defray. To qualify for a grant, applications must be received  
2.24 by the commissioner no later than May 15, 2015. Hospitals and emergency medical  
2.25 services regional boards may not receive grant payments for costs that are reimbursable  
2.26 with available federal funds. Grant amounts shall be based on the total amount of  
2.27 documented eligible expenditures reported by each grant applicant.

2.28 (c) The commissioner of health may use documentation submitted by the hospitals  
2.29 or emergency medical services regional boards regarding Ebola related expenditures,  
2.30 without further verification, for purposes of determining a grant award under paragraph  
2.31 (b). The hospital chief executive or chief financial officer or the emergency medical  
2.32 service regional boards must certify that the data submitted is accurate and that no changes  
2.33 were made in the organization's accounting and record-keeping practices or policies

3.1 for the purpose of creating eligibility or increasing the organization's allocation. The  
3.2 commissioner may audit or verify the data submitted.

3.3 (d) All appropriations in this section are onetime."
