Bill Description

This bill adds coverage for oral health screenings in the Medical Assistance and MinnesotaCare programs and adds to the current statutory definition of providers eligible for the 9.65 percent rate increase for dental services currently paid to providers located outside the seven county Minneapolis Saint Paul metropolitan area.

Section one adds oral health screenings to the covered services under Minnesota Statutes 256B.0625. Coverage for screenings is limited to once per patient per year. Services must be provided in a community setting, and providers are required to arrange follow up services with a licensed dentist.

Section two adds to the current definition of providers eligible for the 9.65 percent dental rate increase in Minnesota Statutes section 256B.76. The rate increase currently applies to dental services rendered by dental providers located outside the seven county metro area. Under this language, this rate increase will also apply to all dental services provided by mobile clinics when providing onsite face to face services at a location outside the seven county metro effective January 1, 2017.

Assumptions

Section one of the bill adds coverage for oral health screenings. This estimate assumes that 25 percent of enrolled children and 10 percent of enrolled adults will receive oral health screenings at a cost of \$9.35 per service. Adding this new covered service would result in an increase in total dental payments for MA and MinnesotaCare of approximately 1.28 percent.

Under Minnesota Statutes 256B.69 sub. 5a, requirements applicable to managed care programs under 256B and 256L established after the date of the contract take effect when the contract is next issued or renewed. Because this language does not specify an effective date for the new covered service in managed care, this estimate assumes January 1, 2017 effective date for screenings in managed care and assumes the July 1, 2016 effective date of the bill for the added coverage in fee for service.

Section two of the bill changes the definition of providers eligible for the 9.65 percent dental rate increase in section 256B.76. This estimate assumes that the rate increase will apply to providers currently receiving the increase and,

effective January 1, 2017 additional dental providers when rendering mobile dental services outside the metro area. Based on department data and data from dental providers, it is estimated that approximately .07 percent of fee for service dental payments and .02 percent of managed care payments are for mobile dental services that would receive this increase.

MN-IT staff reviewed this legislation for impacts to DHS information technology (IT) systems. Applying the rate increase to mobile dental services provided outside of the metro area requires work within DHS claims payment systems. The cost of systems work needed to implement this change is reflected in this estimate.
