Entrepreneurs First(E1)

F1 was created out of a collaboration between **GreenSeam** as the ag expert and a southeast MN collaboration of seven organizations. They received a Minnesota Launch Grant to develop the program to support and develop entrepreneurs.



GreenSeam has coordinated with more than entrepreneurs ranging from tech to production to clean water through E1.
