### **Bill Description**

This bill amends Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 256R.53, subdivision 2. The bill provides Eventide Lutheran Home in Moorhead an operating rate increase effective January 1, 2020, and annually thereafter for each year that the median operating payment rate at a weight of 1.0 for nonprofit nursing facilities located in adjacent cites in North Dakota exceeds the equivalent for Eventide under the Minnesota Value-Based Reimbursement system.

## **Assumptions**

This bill can be implemented within the existing administrative resources of the Department.

The effective date of the rate adjustments in this bill is January 1, 2020.

Minnesota's first fiscal year related to this bill ends on June 30, 2020.

Payment for services lags the provision of services by one month.

The number of annual Medicaid days will remain the same each year for this facility through FY 2021.

The state share of costs/savings is determined by amounts paid by other governmental units:

- the federal share ranges from 51% to 51.11%; a small amount of payments are eligible for higher federal rates;
- the county share ranges from 1.07% to 1.11%;
- the state share is the total minus the federal share and the county share.

The North Dakota rates will increase by 1% effective January 1, 2019.

The operating rates for the Moorhead facility were adjusted for 2020 and 2021 based on the November 2017 forecast.

#### **Expenditure and/or Revenue Formula**

This calculation was based on the nursing facility operating rate in effect on January 1, 2018 for the rate that has a case-mix weight of 1.0 for the Moorhead facility and from January 1, 2018 for the North Dakota facilities. Both North Dakota and Minnesota facilities have 1.0 operating rates. The North Dakota median 1.0 operating rate of nonprofit facilities located in Fargo was used for a comparison to the 1.0 operating rate of Eventide Lutheran Home in Moorhead. The difference between these two rates was multiplied by the number of Medicaid days (based upon the 9/30/17 cost report) for each

RUGs class. The increases for each RUGs class were summed to determine the total estimated cost of this proposal.

In October 2018, information will need to be obtained from the North Dakota Department of Human Services to determine the equivalent operating rates of nonprofit facilities in bordering cites for rates effective January 1, 2020.

Beginning in FY2020, there will be an annual cost to this bill each year the median nursing facility payment rate in the Fargo area exceeds the Minnesota VBR payment rate for this facility.

## **Local Fiscal Impact**

Beginning in FY2020, there will be a small annual cost to counties each year the median nursing facility payment rate in the Fargo area exceeds the Minnesota VBR rate for this facility.
