LSS is a provider of essential services across all 87 counties with more than 2,500 employees serving 1 in 65 Minnesotans every year. LSS provides housing services and support to help youth, adults, people with disabilities, families, older adults and veterans live healthier and more satisfying lives. We also work closely with housing developers and property owners to provide safe and stable housing for people we serve.

In this collaborative work providing emergency assistance, landlord support, eviction support and more, in communities across the state of Minnesota, LSS has gained first-hand knowledge on how these policies will lead to more stable housing and healthier communities.

We also know that racial disparities are significant among people experiencing homelessness. Additionally, our BIPOC neighbors face severe cost burdens related to housing and experience barriers to homeownership at disproportionate rates.
