1.3 "Section 1. **CHILD CARE VIDEO SECURITY CAMERA PILOT PROGRAM.**

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Definitions.** (a) For the purposes of this section, the following terms have
1.5 the meanings given.

1.6 (b) "Child care program" means:

1.7 (1) a family or group family child care home licensed under Minnesota Rules, chapter
1.8 9502;

1.9 (2) a child care center licensed under Minnesota Rules, chapter 9503; and

1.10 (3) a license-exempt child care center certified under chapter 142C.

1.11 (c) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of children, youth, and families.

1.12 (d) "Pilot program" means the child care video security camera pilot program.

1.13 Subd. 2. **Establishment.** The commissioner must establish the child care video security
1.14 camera pilot program to assess the effect of video security cameras on the health and safety
1.15 of children under the care of a child care program.

1.16 Subd. 3. **Program administration and procedures.** (a) The commissioner is responsible
1.17 for the administration and oversight of the pilot program, including the establishment of
1.18 policies and procedures, data collection and reporting requirements, and compliance.

1.19 (b) A child care program must apply to participate in the pilot program in a form and
1.20 manner prescribed by the commissioner. No more than 300 child care programs may be
1.21 approved to participate in the pilot program.

2.1 (c) The commissioner must finish updating or installing video security cameras in all
2.2 child care programs participating in the pilot program by January 15, 2027.

2.3 Subd. 4. **Survey required.** (a) On or before January 15, 2028, the commissioner must
2.4 survey the participants of the pilot program. At a minimum, the survey must include questions
2.5 about:

2.6 (1) the effect on child safety of having video security cameras in a child care program;

2.7 (2) the feasibility of implementing and maintaining video security cameras in a child
2.8 care program;

2.9 (3) the recording retention, disposal, dissemination, and access policies associated with
2.10 the video security cameras;

2.11 (4) the staff training requirements for proper implementation and maintenance of video
2.12 security cameras and recordings; and

2.13 (5) parent and legal guardian feedback on the presence of video security cameras in a
2.14 child care program.

2.15 (b) The license or certification holder of each participating child care program must
2.16 complete the survey.

2.17 Subd. 5. **Report to the legislature.** On or before March 1, 2028, the commissioner must
2.18 submit a report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over child care summarizing
2.19 the results of the pilot program. At a minimum, the report must include:

2.20 (1) the number of child care programs that participated in the pilot program;

2.21 (2) the total cost of implementing and maintaining video security cameras for each child
2.22 care program;

2.23 (3) the number of maltreatment and child safety related cases at each child care program
2.24 during the pilot program;

2.25 (4) the number of maltreatment and child safety related cases at each child care program
2.26 in the 12 months prior to video camera installation under the pilot program;

2.27 (5) recommendations for video security camera placement in each type of child care
2.28 program;

2.29 (6) recommendations for data storage and cybersecurity policies;

2.30 (7) recommendations for the funding of video security cameras in a child care program;

2.31 (8) the results of the survey under subdivision 4; and

3.1 (9) any other information the commissioner deems relevant on the pilot program.
