

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 922 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, line 17, delete the comma and after "and" insert ", except as provided in
1.3 paragraph (g),"

1.4 Page 2, after line 32, insert:

1.5 "(g) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a referendum to levy the amount needed to
1.6 finance a district's response to a disaster or emergency may be held on a date set by the
1.7 board. "Disaster" means a situation that creates an actual or imminent serious threat to
1.8 the health and safety of persons, or a situation that has resulted or is likely to result in
1.9 catastrophic loss to property or the environment. "Emergency" means an unforeseen
1.10 combination of circumstances that calls for immediate action to prevent a disaster from
1.11 developing or occurring."

1.12 Page 7, delete section 8

1.13 Page 7, line 12, after the period insert "This paragraph does not apply to an election
1.14 on levying a tax or issuing debt obligations to finance the local government's response
1.15 to a disaster or emergency. An election for these purposes may be held on a date set
1.16 by the governing body. "Disaster" means a situation that creates an actual or imminent
1.17 serious threat to the health and safety of persons, or a situation that has resulted or is
1.18 likely to result in catastrophic loss to property or the environment. "Emergency" means
1.19 an unforeseen combination of circumstances that calls for immediate action to prevent a
1.20 disaster from developing or occurring."

1.21 Page 18, after line 16, insert:

1.22 "Subd. 4. **Exception for disaster or emergency.** Subdivisions 2 and 3, and any
1.23 other law requiring an election to approve issuance of bonds or other debt obligations to be
1.24 held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of either an even-numbered
1.25 or odd-numbered year, do not apply to issuance of bonds or other debt obligations to
1.26 finance the municipality's response to an emergency or disaster. "Disaster" means a
1.27 situation that creates an actual or imminent serious threat to the health and safety of

2.1 persons, or a situation that has resulted or is likely to result in catastrophic loss to property
2.2 or the environment. "Emergency" means an unforeseen combination of circumstances that
2.3 calls for immediate action to prevent a disaster from developing or occurring."

2.4 Page 18, line 22, delete "held" and insert "authorized on or"

2.5 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
