1.2 Page 1, line 10, before "A" insert "(a)" and after "student" insert "outside the presence  
1.3 of other persons"

1.4 Page 1, after line 11, insert:

1.5 "(b) This section does not apply:

1.6 (1) to a student for whom the school has an individualized family service plan, an  
1.7 individualized education program, or a 504 plan in effect that documents the need for the  
1.8 child to be alone with a school employee, independent contractor, or volunteer;

1.9 (2) in an emergency, to address the health or safety of the student or other persons; or

1.10 (3) when the student's parent has consented to the student being alone with a school  
1.11 employee, independent contractor, or volunteer."

1.12 Page 4, delete section 4 and insert:

1.13 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2025 Supplement, section 260E.065, is amended by adding  
1.14 a subdivision to read:

1.15 Subd. 4. **Commissioner of children, youth, and families; education-related mandated**  
1.16 **reporter training module on grooming.** (a) By August 1, 2027, the commissioner of  
1.17 children, youth, and families must develop a training module as part of the commissioner's  
1.18 mandated reporter training that is specifically applicable to professionals or professionals'  
1.19 delegates engaged in education, including but not limited to:

1.20 (1) the requirement to report allegations of maltreatment involving students ages 18  
1.21 through 21, including students receiving special education services, up to and including  
1.22 graduation and the issuance of a secondary or high school diploma; and

- 2.1 (2) addressing grooming and threatened sexual abuse, including the duty to report
- 2.2 grooming as maltreatment under section 260E.06, and how to identify the signs of grooming.
- 2.3 (b) The commissioner must consult with the Minnesota Department of Education while
- 2.4 developing the training module."
