1.6 Subd. 7. **Period of eligibility.** (a) Eligibility is available for the month of application  
1.7 and for three months prior to application if the person was eligible in those prior months.  
1.8 ~~A redetermination of eligibility must occur every 12 months.~~

1.9 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary:

1.10 (1) a child under 19 years of age who is determined eligible for medical assistance must  
1.11 remain eligible for a period of 12 months;

1.12 (2) a child 19 years of age and older but under 21 years of age who is determined eligible  
1.13 for medical assistance must remain eligible for a period of 12 months; and

1.14 (3) a child under six years of age who is determined eligible for medical assistance must  
1.15 remain eligible through the month in which the child reaches six years of age.

1.16 (c) A child's eligibility under paragraph (b) may be terminated earlier if:

1.17 (1) the child or the child's representative requests voluntary termination of eligibility;

1.18 (2) the child ceases to be a resident of this state;

1.19 (3) the child dies;

1.20 (4) the child attains the maximum age; or

2.1 (5) the agency determines eligibility was erroneously granted at the most recent eligibility  
2.2 determination due to agency error or fraud, abuse, or perjury attributed to the child or the  
2.3 child's representative.

2.4 (d) For a person eligible for an insurance affordability program as defined in section  
2.5 256B.02, subdivision 19, who reports a change that makes the person eligible for medical  
2.6 assistance, eligibility is available for the month the change was reported and for three months  
2.7 prior to the month the change was reported, if the person was eligible in those prior months.

2.8 (e) The period of eligibility for an individual eligible for medical assistance under section  
2.9 256B.055, subdivision 15, is six months. The period of eligibility for all other medical  
2.10 assistance enrollees is 12 months.

2.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2027."
