## **Overview**

This bill would establish a no child left inside grant program to be administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR). The program would provide grants to public entities and nonprofit organizations for natural-resource-based education and recreation programs for youth. The program would be similar to a program recently established in the state of Washington.

## Section Description

1 No child left inside grant program.

**Subd. 1. Establishment.** Requires the commissioner of natural resources to administer a program that provides grants for environmental, ecological, and other natural-resource based education and recreation programs for youth.

**Subd. 2. Eligibility.** States that public entities and private nonprofit organizations are eligible for the program.

**Subd. 3. Priorities.** Requires the commissioner to give priority to certain programs.

**Subd. 4. Rule exemption.** Exempts the commissioner from rulemaking procedures when implementing the program.

**Appropriation.** Provides an unspecified appropriation to the DNR for the no child left inside grant program established in section 1.
