I am writing to offer support of HF 1051 which would allow cities to apply administrative rental licensing programs to Sacred Settlement communities. Currently there is no oversight of Sacred Settlement communities through state, county, or local licensing.

Allowing cities the ability to provide rental licensing to Sacred Settlements will help address issues of health, welfare, and safety and provide a point of contact for tenants if issues arise.

Additionally, this bill seeks to clarify requirements for electrical service to micro units. In Minnesota's climate, it is imperative that electricity and heat are provided in a safe and efficient manner to micro units. This bill seeks to clarify that electricity is a required component for the units.
