

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 1826 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. **CROSSWINDS SCHOOL TRANSITION.**

1.4 (a) The Perpich Center for Arts Education must submit to the committees in the house
1.5 of representatives and the senate with jurisdiction over education policy and education
1.6 finance by January 15, 2018, a proposal to convey the real and personal property of the
1.7 Crosswinds school to a school district or nonprofit institution organized under Minnesota
1.8 Statutes, chapter 317A. The report must be submitted in accordance with Minnesota Statutes,
1.9 section 3.195.

1.10 (b) All property of the Crosswinds school shall be transferred to the Department of
1.11 Administration in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 15.039, subdivisions 5 and
1.12 8, effective June 30, 2019, unless the legislature first conveys the property of the Crosswinds
1.13 school to a different entity.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.

1.15 Sec. 2. **PERPICH CENTER REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE.**

1.16 The Perpich Center for Arts Education must examine agency policies and practices to
1.17 address the problems identified in the 2017 program evaluation report, and internal controls
1.18 and compliance audit by the Office of the Legislative Auditor. The Perpich Center may
1.19 consult with the Department of Education, and Minnesota Management and Budget division
1.20 of Management Analysis and Development to determine how to improve management,
1.21 operations, and fulfill its statutory mandates under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 129C. The
1.22 Perpich Center must report to the education committees in the legislature by January 15,
1.23 2019, on its progress under this section, and must identify actions it has taken to address
1.24 the following:

- 2.1 (1) provide appropriate direction and agency oversight;
- 2.2 (2) increase transparency and solicit public input;
- 2.3 (3) increase student enrollment in the Perpich Arts High School;
- 2.4 (4) perform outreach activities and provide support to arts educators and students
- 2.5 throughout Minnesota; and
- 2.6 (5) improve student performance on state assessments.
- 2.7 The report must identify the number of applicants and students admitted from each
- 2.8 congressional district for the three years preceding the report.
- 2.9 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
