

Subject Liquor service and sale - minors

Summary

State law prohibits individuals under the age of 18 from making on- and off-sales of intoxicating liquor. In addition, current law also prohibits local ordinances that bar individuals under the age of 21 from performing work for the establishment, including the service of alcohol.

H.F. 2806 would temporarily (for two years) allow an individual who is 17 years of age to sell and serve alcohol at an establishment holding an on-sale intoxicating liquor license, notwithstanding any state or local law to the contrary.
