1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to child care licensing; requiring the commissioner of children, youth, and
1.3 families to amend rules on teacher's aides.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER; AMENDING STAFF
1.6 DISTRIBUTION RULES FOR CHILD CARE CENTERS.

1.7 The commissioner of children, youth, and families shall amend Minnesota Rules to make
1.8 the exception in Laws 2023, chapter 70, article 8, section 63, permanent. Notwithstanding
1.9 any other requirements for good cause exempt rulemaking, the commissioner may use the
1.10 procedure under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subdivision 1, clause (3), for changes
1.11 to Minnesota Rules pursuant to this section. Minnesota Statutes, section 14.386, does not
1.12 apply to rules amended pursuant to this section except as provided under Minnesota Statutes,
1.13 section 14.388. The commissioner must submit a proposed rule pursuant to this section to
1.14 the Office of Administrative Hearings pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388,
1.15 subdivision 1, no later than June 1, 2025.

1.16 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
