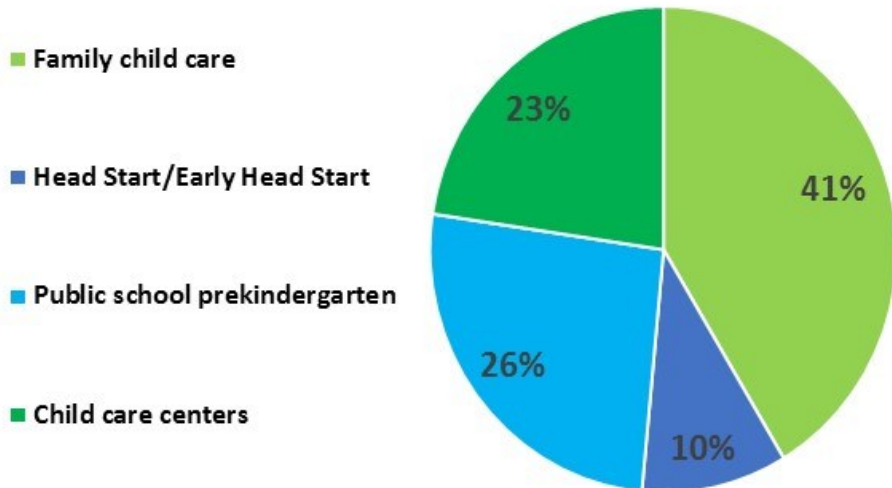


Parent Aware Rated Programs and Children Served by Program Type

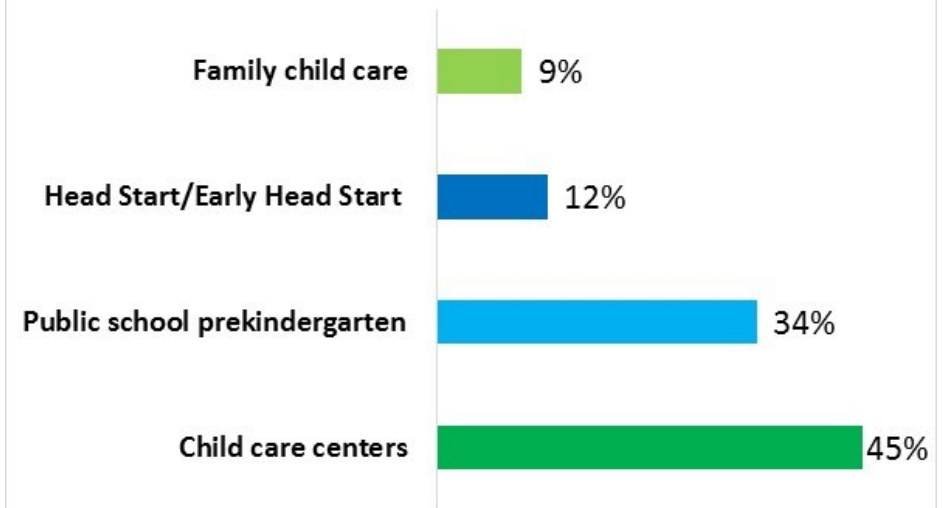
Parent Aware is a voluntary program available to licensed family child care programs, child care centers, Head Start, and public school prekindergarten programs. Currently, there are 2,827 Parent Aware Rated programs serving 99,347 children.

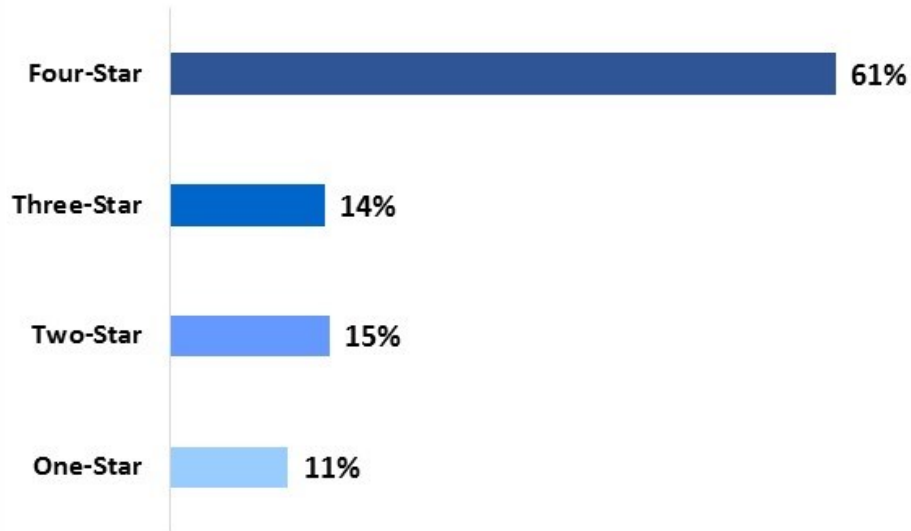

Parent Aware Rated Programs and Children Served by Star-Rating Level

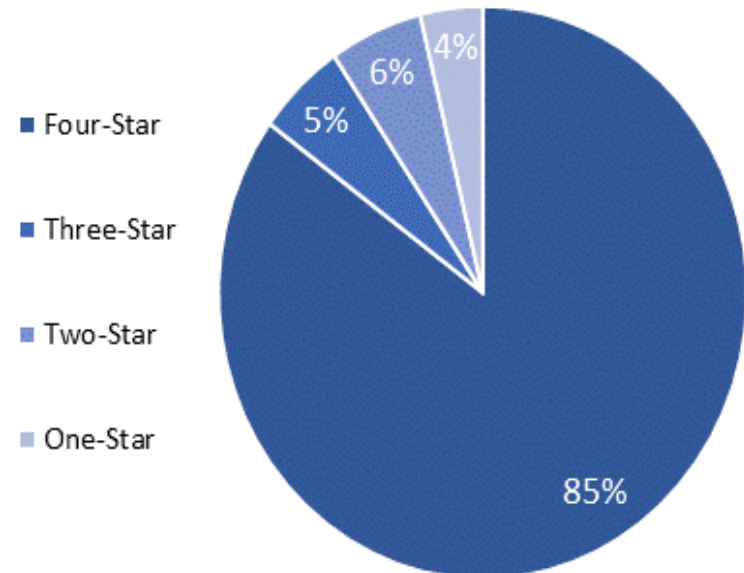
