

- B3 Sustainable Building 2030 Energy Standard is a progressive energy conservation program designed to significantly reduce the energy and carbon in MN commercial, institutional and industrial buildings.
- Our design incorporates B3 requirements
- Additional B3 requirement for solar energy which would incorporate a solar field and/or solar credits (exact solution TBD)
- Estimated B3 costs \$3.9million plus solar solution at estimated \$2.2 million=\$6.1 million

Regional Justice Involved Female program plan

- Final Arrowhead Regional Probation plan will allow for consistency in planning for male and female inmates
- Curriculum will be responsive to Risk, Need and Responsivity via assessments of the women who are likely to use the JIF program
- Trauma informed, strength based, gender specific, culturally competent programming with holistic approach
- Wrap around services allowing for a return to our community will be a targeted focus

Holistic Person Centered Care plan

- Medical area that services entire jail population
 - Carlton County Social worker office inside Jail space
 - Fond du Lac Tribal dedicated staff office inside Jail space
 - Interview/counseling room for trauma intervention
 - Nurse station with medical exam room.
 - Ability to utilize telemedicine for Mental Health visits
