

1.1 ..... moves to amend H.F. No. 4135, the first engrossment, as follows:

1.2 Page 5, delete section 14 and insert:

1.3 "Sec. 14. ANALYSIS AND REPORT REQUIRED; PFAS IN BIOSOLID  
1.4 AGRICULTURAL AND RETAIL FERTILIZERS.

1.5 (a) Pursuant to Minnesota Rules, part 7041.1500, subpart 3, and until December 31,  
1.6 2024, the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency, in consultation with the  
1.7 commissioner of agriculture, must require a statistically significant random sample of sewage  
1.8 sludge prepared for application to agricultural land in Minnesota, and Milorganite and other  
1.9 bagged fertilizers or soil amendments derived from sewage sludge, be analyzed for the  
1.10 presence of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

1.11 (b) No later than February 1, 2025, the commissioner must submit a report the legislative  
1.12 committees with jurisdiction over agriculture and the environment with the commissioner's  
1.13 findings and recommendations, including but not limited to recommendations for:

1.14 (1) an appropriate ceiling concentration and cumulative pollutant loading rate; and

1.15 (2) where sewage sludge prepared for application to agricultural land may be applied."
