BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Issuance by county or city.** The governing body of a city or county may issue off-sale or on-sale licenses for the sale of 3.2 percent malt liquor within their respective jurisdictions. If the governing body elects, an on-sale 3.2 percent malt liquor license may also authorize the sale of intoxicating malt liquor not exceeding 4.5 percent alcohol by volume to persons attending a qualifying sporting event. For purposes of this subdivision, "qualifying sporting event" means any amateur sporting event featuring a local sports team but does not include an event held under the auspices of the Minnesota State High School League or a collegiate league. Any licenses issued under this subdivision shall be considered a 3.2 percent malt liquor license for purposes of this chapter.
